

Business Advisory Councils

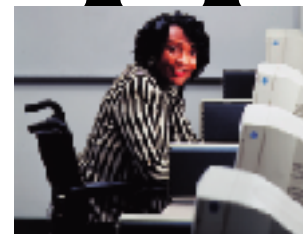
